# **HODNET PARISH COUNCIL**

Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held in Lyon Hall, Hodnet on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> December 2013

Also present - Mr P Sutton - Director Shropshire Housing Group

Mr Sutton came to The Parish Council Meeting to give an update for the plans re the former Auction Yard in Station Road. He explained that the site formerly belonging to Shropshire Council had been identified for 12 homes in the Local Development Plan however this figure this was a crude calculation by North Shropshire District Council based on 12 homes per acre. Originally Shropshire Housing Group had planned to put 19 homes on the site but following public consultation and a meeting with the Parish Council this number had been reduce to 16. The Parish Council agreed at the Council meeting to request that the number of homes be reduced to 12. Mr Sutton stressed that the Shropshire Housing Group has always been mindful of the wishes of the local community but in reducing the number of homes from 16 to 12 that meant 4 families could not be housed and he candidly admitted that the development became less economically viable. He therefore proposed that the number of homes be reduced to 14 and showed the Council the new layout. After some discussion the Parish Council approved of the new plan and Shropshire Housing Group will now resubmit this amended format. Councillor Powell thanked Mr Sutton for attending the meeting.

### Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 1st November 2012

Councillor Morgan proposed the minutes be signed as a true record of proceedings seconded by Councillor Taylor and all agreed.

Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held on Friday 23rd November

Councillor Hodge proposed the minutes be signed as a true record of proceedings seconded by Councillor Morgan and all agreed.

#### 46. Hearne Lane

The Chairman advised the Council that the Planning Application for a new Car Park has been withdrawn. It was noted that commercial vehicles and staff vehicles were being parked up on the pavement just before the opening to Chantry Court. The Clerk was asked to write to both Ringway and Shropshire Council to request that this practice is stopped immediately.

### 47. Hodnet Working Mens Club

In order to clarify the extent of the Parish Council ownership of the Club and Grounds, the Clerk had obtained copy Land Registry Documents. These documents verified the Council understanding of their ownership but it was noted that there was a Counterpart Lease which had expired this year covering the showers and changing rooms. The Clerk was asked to seek Legal Advice and get the Lease renewed.

# 48. Former Auction Yard, Station Road – Item 24

Now that the plans have been supported by the Council, a Local Letting Agreement needs to be agreed between the Parish Council and Shropshire Housing Group. Initial information from Shropshire Council would seem to require that such an Agreement may only be in place for a maximum of 3 years. The Clerk was asked to enquire at Shropshire Council and Shropshire Housing Group if there was a standard Local Lettings Agreement available and why there was a time limitation of 3 years.

The Clerk will also advise Shropshire Housing Group of their support for the revised plan shown at the Meeting tonight providing a long term Local Lettings Plan is in place.

# 49. Development at Land East of Shrewsbury Street Ref 12/0818/FUL

The Chairman advised the meeting that the North Planning Committee had refused permission for this development.

# 50. Precept

The Clerk explained that the Parish Council was precluded from discussing the Precept for next year on advice from Shropshire Council. Under the new Localism Bill it appears that Councillors could have a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest if they were to set the Precept for next year. Since all the Parish Councillors reside in the Parish, all would be excluded from the discussion, a totally unworkable position. Latest information from Shropshire Council Legal Department advises that dispensation from Shropshire Council is being sought for all Councillors in due course.

### 51. Hodnet Website

The Parish Council wished to thank Randall Hardy for his sterling work on Hodnet Website. It was Proposed by Councillor Revel and seconded by Councillor Parker and all agreed that £50 in vouchers be sent to Mr Hardy with grateful thanks from the Parish Council.

### 54. Parking Outside Hodnet School – Item 43

Pc Sturland has replied to the Parish Council that he too is concerned with the standard of parking outside the school and has visited the school at peak drop off and pick up times. As a temporary measure he has left some 'no waiting 'cones for the school to use but had advised the Head Teacher

to get in touch with Dave Gradwell (Area Traffic Engineer- Shropshire Council). Mrs Gardner the Head Teacher has also responded, saying that this problem is frequently highlighted in the School Newsletter and she has arranged an onsite meeting with Mr Gradwell. Following this meeting, Mr Gradwell has written to the Parish Council with plans for 'School Keep Clear' markings on the School side of the road. The Clerk was asked to respond to Mr Gradwell confirming that the Council is happy for him to proceed as soon as possible.

- Street Lights not working;-H37 & H32 on The Meadow, the Clerk will advise V &W Electrics accordingly
