Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held in Lyon Hall Hodnet on Thursday 26 June 2014

Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 22 May 2014 Councillor Morgan proposed the minutes be signed as a true record of proceedings seconded by Councillor Cope all agreed.

Matters Arising

Football Netting – Item 73

The goalpost have been removed from the top of the field and repositioned at the other end resulting in no further complaints from residents. The Council was concerned to note that the stop netting has not been dismantled and remains nailed to a tree. The Clerk was asked to contact Ms Heath and request that the stop netting is removed as soon as possible.

Recreation Ground Repairs – Item 106 17.

The Clerk has not yet received the measurement to order the new chain and tyres for the tyre walk, she will speak to Mr Wellings shortly after this meeting.

18. Cow Lane - Item 5

Shropshire Council have cleared the lane but unfortunately we have been advised by Mr Underwood that garden waste has been deposited own the lane. The Clerk was asked to write to the local residents to request any information they may have on who might be fly tipping down the lane. Mr Underwood also suggested that nettles at the top of the lane and some Himaliyum Balsam further down be included in this year's spraying schedule – the Council agreed and the Clerk will instruct the contractors accordingly.

19. **Drayton Road – Item 7**

Neither PC Sturland nor Shropshire Highways can assist and both have referred the Parish Council to David Gradwell of Shropshire Council Traffic Engineering Team. The Clerk is in diary to submit a community led concern to the Traffic Engineering Team at the next allowable date which will be the end of September. In the meantime Councillor Willicombe will seek advice on the criteria required to impose a road weight limit.

20. Automated External Defibrillator (AED) for Hodnet – Item 8

Whilst a request for volunteers has been placed in various venues and on the Website and Parish Newsletter the take up has been poor. As the scheme cannot get off the ground without sufficient volunteers it was suggested that the Clerk write to all the various Clubs. Groups and Societies in Hodnet, Phil Benbow of Hodnet Fire Station and the Head Teacher at Hodnet School to enlist their help in finding volunteers. Councillor Hodge confirmed that any training required will be provided free of charge by West Midland Ambulance Heartstart Team.

21. Street Light Electricity – Item 10

Highline Electrical has quoted £132 plus Vat to test 20% of Street Lights (16) – all agreed to accept the quote and start a 5 year review.

22. Weed Spraying – Item 13

The weed spraying has not commenced – the Clerk was asked to chase up the contractors.

23. Neighbourhood Plan – Item 14

Councillor Hodge attended a recent LJC Meeting – a report is attached see appdx 1. Unfortunately no headway was made regarding an overall Neighbourhood Plan for the LJC area . Bearing in mind the proposed developments for Hodnet, Councillor Hodge stated that Hodnet simply could not wait for the LJC plan and therefore will forge ahead with a complete review of the Parish Plan – \sec Item 27

24. Marchamley Footpath

Councillor Powell reported that the footpath had been filled in but not rolled. The Clerk was asked to contact Richard Knight of Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships thanking them for making good the path and requesting that the sides are cut back to enable weed spraying to be undertaken.
