ADDERLEY

MARKET DRAYTON

TERN HILL

WOLLERTON



A Halt opened in 1930's. Northbound Facilities, as South, Were Basic.

Note. The remains of the old station gate at the top of slope/steps to the right can still be seen next to the road bridge above Wollerton Tennis Club. Parts of the platform also survive.
