Outline of the route

This walk, using an old railway line and lanes, goes to **Wollerton**—or beyond. It starts at the Hodnet Social Club's car park (free parking).

To start, cross the recreation ground and go past the swings to reach a PG onto Station Road. Turn right and head to the old railway line bridge. Steps and a PG lead down to the former Wellington to Market Drayton railway line, from where you head towards Wollerton. Along here, in summer, you may see/hear Buzzards, Skylarks or even Curlews and, at the right time of year*, might even spot some Glow Worms – the colony here being rare.

*The best time to see them is after dark on June/July evenings, in the taller plants at the edge of the short (rabbit 'mown') grassland.

After a PG at the end of the old line, turn right. 2 more PG take you to Wollerton, where you can visit the **Old Hall Garden** or view an unusual **Stray Animal Pound**. If not extending your walk at 'A', return the way you came.

Option. At 'A' go down Mill Road to the bypass. Cross it and go through a PG, then turn right. After a FG, the track becomes a lane. Approx 50m ahead turn right and follow the lane to its end, then turn right and cross the bypass again. After a PG, walk up Station Road to return back to the start—if not taking the option below.

Option. At 'B' go down Webster Lane where 5 PG take you to Espley Roundabout. From here, you can return to the start via one of two routes, as shown on the map.
