

## Our Walks

Ten varied walks have been published:

Walk 1	- the 'Glow Worm Walk'	- Grade 1
Walk 2	- the 'Long Lane Walk'	- Grade 2
Walk 3	- the 'Permissive Path Walk'	- Grade 2
Walk 4	- the 'History Walk'	- Grade 1
Walk 5	- the 'Wetlands Walk'	- Grade 2
Walk 6	- the 'Two Parishes Walk'	- Grade 3
Walk 7	- the 'Fauls Circular Walk'	- Grade 3
Walk 8	- the 'Hawgreen Walk'	- Grade 2
Walk 9	- the 'Tern Valley Walk'	- Grade 2
Walk 10	- the 'Bluebell Walk'	- Grade 1

What do we mean by the stated 'Grades'?

Our Grades are a guide to how strenuous the walks are:

**Grade 1** = Shorter/level route &/or no or few stiles

**Grade 2** = Moderate length/part hilly route &/or some stiles

**Grade 3** = Longer/hilly route &/or many stiles

What do we mean by 'Dog Friendly'?

That larger dogs can use dog gates/easily avoid any stiles.

**Note.** We assume small dogs can be lifted/use stile gaps

## Walking around Hodnet

Hodnet is a pretty village with various amenities, and is located in the pleasant countryside of North Shropshire.

Hodnet's location makes it ideal for walking, and this leaflet provides a overview of ten local walk leaflets published by the **Hodnet Footpath Group (HFG)**.

The approx locations/routes of the walks are shown overleaf, with each leaflet providing a detailed map and outline description of the route(s) to be followed.

### Using Public Rights Of Way (PROW)

Whilst HFG undertakes some basic maintenance and liaises with owners/tenants ('occupiers') of land across which various PROW exist, it is the occupiers of land who have responsibility for maintaining safe/unrestricted access to them.

If you find a PROW blocked by crops you are entitled to walk through them but otherwise, and in the event of other blockages, it is suggested you take the shortest safe detour around the problem.
